Why Go to the National Specialty?

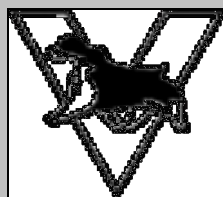

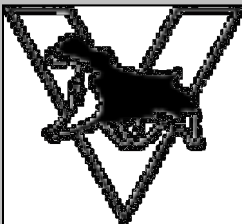

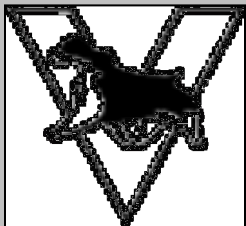
Tribute to Fran Nelson

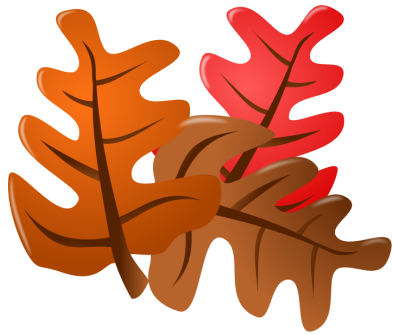


TCVESSA lost one of its founding members with the passing of Frances Sedgwick Nelson in late May at the age of 96. Fran – “Mrs. Nelson” to so many – helped start TCVESSA in 1977 and served as its newsletter editor for many years. She was a huge fan of Springers, raising puppies and accompanying Francie to Springer specialties, all breed shows and obedience trials in the early days. She befriended some wonderful breed experts – she served tea to Bea Brown at a National Specialty, and she shared a love of antiques with Julie Gasow when we were invited to lunch at Salilyn. Mom’s copy of Bea Brown’s “The English Springer Spaniel in North America” contains personal notes and autographs from everyone she ever met at specialty shows. She kept a puppy from one of our litters, the black tri top-producer Ch. Chuzzlewit’s Courier, “Page,” whom we co-owned. She earned a CD with her very own Springer, “Prudence,” one of her proudest moments.

I’d like to thank TCVESSA and club members who made generous gifts to the English Springer Foundation in her memory. I’d also like to thank so many TCVESSA friends who sent cards, notes, and e-mails. Your thoughtfulness and support has been so deeply appreciated.

Mom’s memorial celebration will be held on Friday, October 12 at 2 PM at Judson Church, 4101 Harriet Avenue South, Minneapolis.

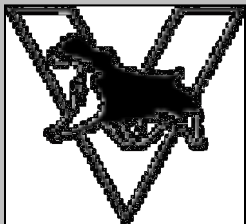
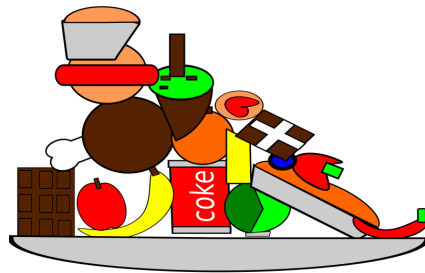

Five Years ago when the VOX editor resigned I stepped up to fill in until a new Editor could be found.

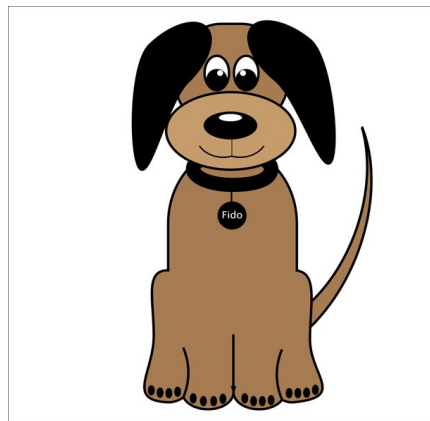
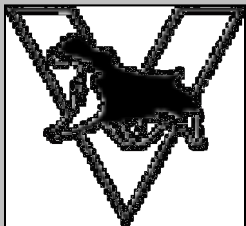
Over the last five years I have posted this position a few times and yet nobody has offered to take on this position.

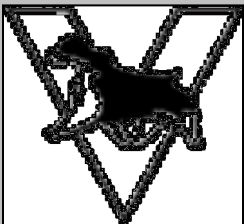
